The Diploma in Accounting (DIA) is designed to equip students with all the necessary technical skills and knowledge that are required to fulfill an accounting role at the technician level. It is also structured to provide a sound knowledge that is required of a professional accounting executive.

DIA covers a wide range of key accounting and finance areas such as how to interpret financial statements, plan, manage and measure performance using budgets and other financial techniques, make financial decisions and manage all kinds of financial risks.

Graduates of the DIA are exempted from three ACCA (The Association of Chartered Certified Accountants) papers and six ICAEW (Institute of Chartered Accountants in England and Wales) papers.
