With rapid globalisation, the Straits of Malacca has become one of the busiest shipping routes in the world. 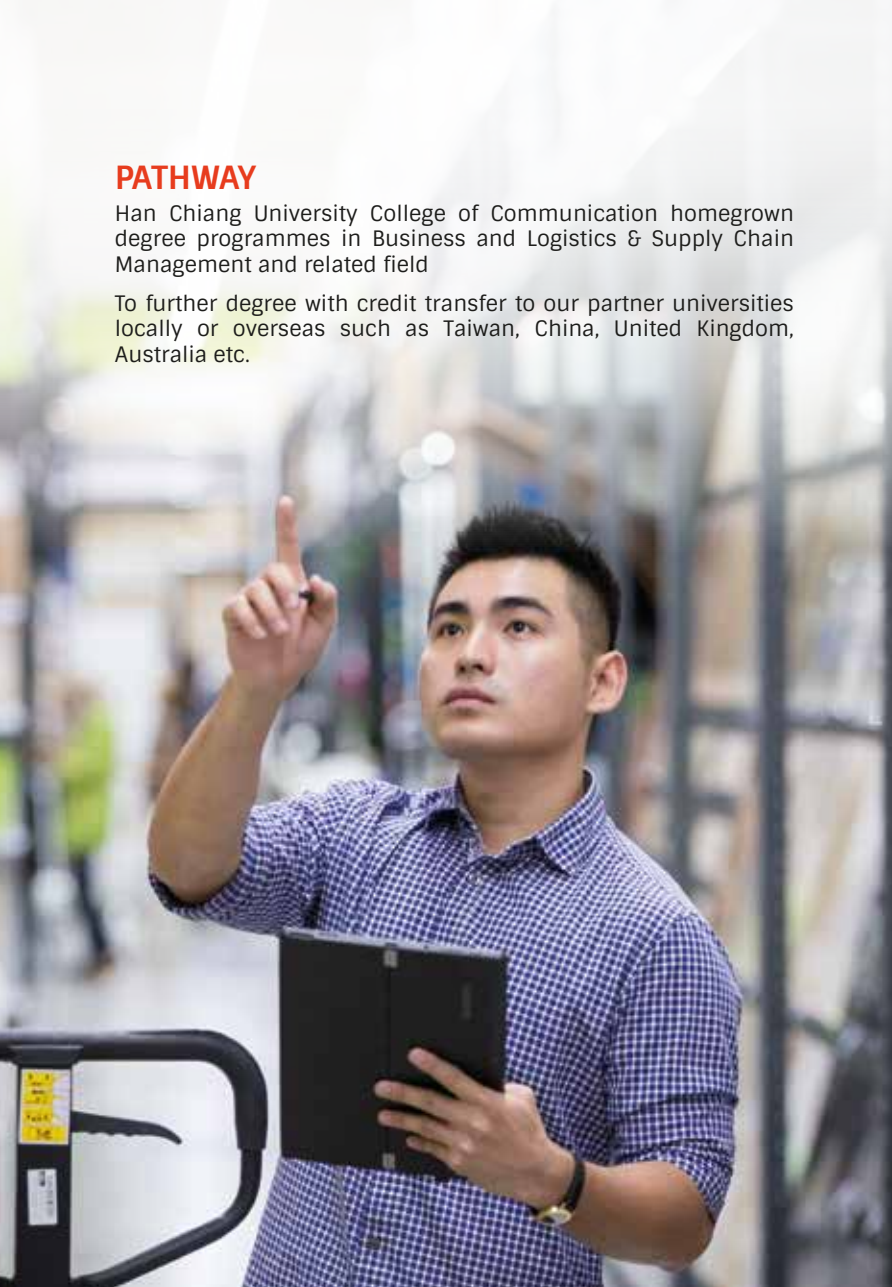
